



Weingut Jordan – Tradition Meets Innovation in Austria's Wine Quarter

Wineries are not created overnight – they are shaped by generations into what they are today. Since 1858, knowledge about wine has been developed and carefully passed down from one generation to the next at Weingut Jordan. Inspired by this tradition, Simone and her husband Hannes now manage the modern family winery in the beautiful Weinviertel region in its fourth generation.

The foundation for the long-lived Jordan wines is clearly the soil of their homeland. In the white wine-dominated Weinviertel, the Pulkau vineyards form a red wine island – which also explains the winery's affinity for red wine. In addition to expressive red wines from Zweigelt and St. Laurent, the soils around Pulkau also enable an impressive range of Grüner Veltliners – from classically peppery to single-vineyard wines aged in wooden barrels or granite stone casks, to elegant winegrower Sekts.

Sparkling Excellence with International Success: The winery's Sekts – Grüner Veltliner Brut Reserve, Riesling Brut Große Reserve, and Blanc de Noir Brut Reserve – have received multiple international awards, including GOLD at the Glass of Bubbly Awards in London and top ratings in renowned magazines such as Falstaff and Vinaria.

Simone and Hannes vinify wines with passion and sensitivity that leave a lasting impression and receive national and international recognition.
